S-M-A-R-T Goals

Each of your goals must be written in the S-M-A-R-T Goals format. S-M-A-R-T Goals stand for:

S: Specific. Goals that are specific make the desired outcome better. Avoid generalities and broad, sweeping statements.

M: Measurable. How will you prove the objective was achieved? Numbers are good proof of results, so go ahead and add quantitative information to your goals.

A: Attainable. Be sure you can really do what you set out to do.

R: Relevant. Does the goal match what we or you are trying to accomplish? Setting goals for the sake of goal-setting is a big mistake.

T: Time-Oriented. When will this goal be achieved? Set deadlines. For example, "It will be done by March 15."
